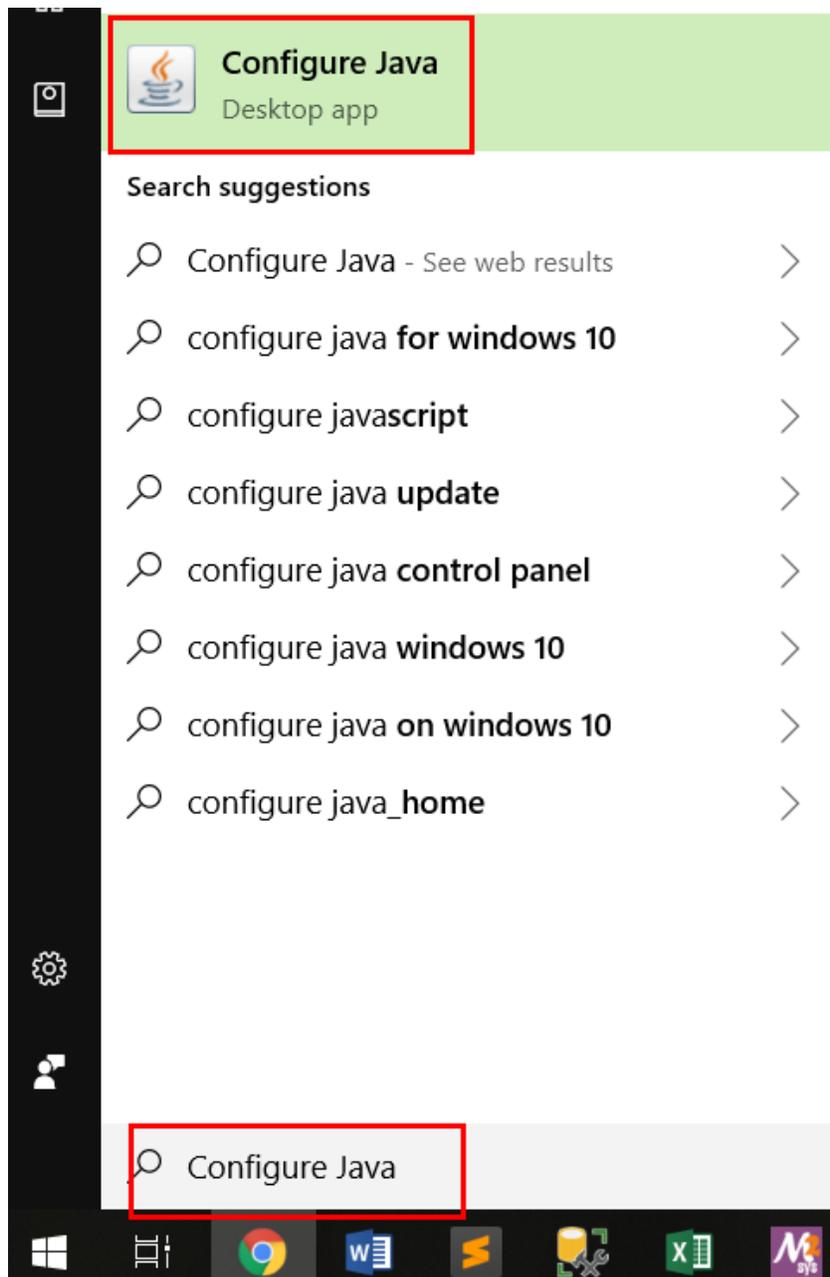


Downgrading Your Java Version

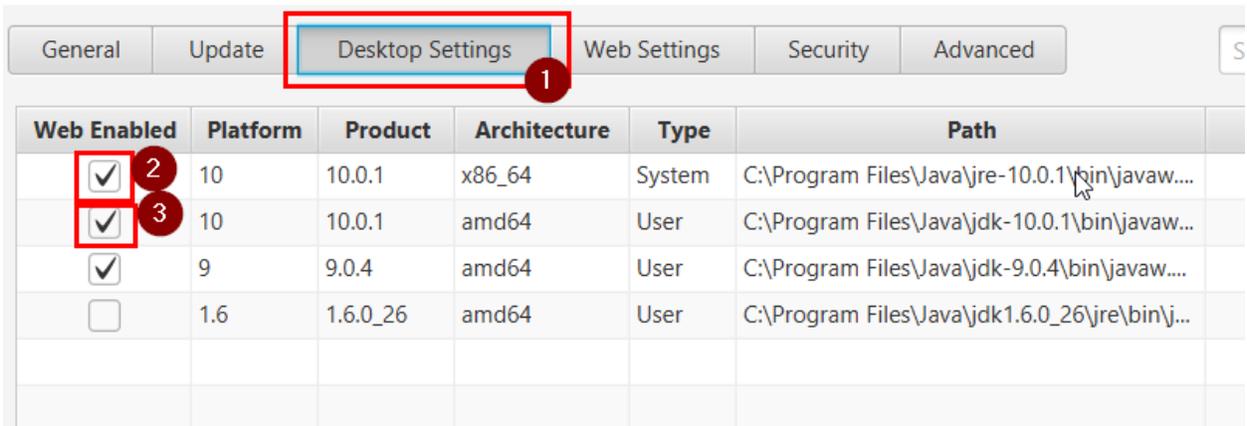
If you have updated Java 11 and would like to revert to a previously installed version, follow these directions:

If you do not have an earlier version of Java installed, you can [download Java 9 here](#) or you can [download Java 8 here](#).

1) Use the built in search feature of windows to find "Configure Java"



2) Uncheck versions of Java you do not want to be active:

In this example, after unchecking Java 10, Java 9 will be set as the active Java run time to be used.
