Session Descriptions		
Asset Management features in Citywide	In this session, we'll cover efficient asset management strategies, including navigating the asset inventory, creating custom views, sorting and filtering data, and reviewing and adjusting asset information. We'll also explore the Bulk Upload and Editing tools, focusing on the Upload Centre, upload types, templates, and default values for streamlined processes. Additionally, we'll dive into financial reporting and provide tips for maximizing the Upload Centre's functionality. If time permits, we'll finish with hands-on exercises to reinforce key concepts. This session is designed for existing Citywide users looking to dive deeper into the Asset Management features they may not yet be using. We'll focus on setting up and utilizing Asset Profiles within the Citywide software, exploring how they work in conjunction with lifecycle events and strategies. By understanding the full potential of Asset Profiles, you'll learn how to streamline your asset management processes and better track asset progress through their lifecycle. This session is not focused on industry standards or best practices, but rather on practical, actionable insights for maximizing the capabilities of your Citywide system.	
Citywide Permitting - Enhancements	In this session, we'll dive deep into the latest permitting features and enhancements, exploring how these updates can improve your workflows and increase efficiency. You'll learn how to effectively use the new tools and functionalities within the system to manage permits with greater ease. The session will include hands-on experience by logging into the training database, allowing you to apply the features in real-time. Whether you're new to permitting or looking to enhance your current processes, this session will equip you with the knowledge and skills to make the most of the latest updates.

Learning Citywide Assets from a New User's Perspective* In this session, we will be going back to basics where we wil learn to navigate, administrate the system and explore the basic functionality. Learning Objectives include:

- 2. How to Filter and manage the asset inventory and run financial reports
- 3. Understand asset profiles and their function and running asset management & level of service reports
- 4. Review suggested process for year end asset adjustments and how to enter various types of asset adjustments

Citywide Maintenance - Mobile App and Route Patrol Best Practices	This session will focus on best practices for utilizing the Citywide Mobile app to update work orders, service requests, completing processes as well as streamlining route patrol activities. You'll learn how to enhance patrol efficiency, improve data accuracy, and ensure service compliance on municipal roadways. We'll cover how to effectively use the app for real-time updates, reporting, and tracking, helping you stay organized and responsive while on patrol. Whether you're new to the app or looking to optimize your current processes, this session will provide valuable strategies to ensure smooth and compliant route patrol operations.		
Working Session: Citywide Assets & Maintenance	This interactive working session will walk you through key end-to-end scenarios in the Citywide Assets & Maintenance process. Attendees will explore the lifecycle from submitting a Service Request via the Citywide Portal through to Work Order creation, assignment, and completion. Additional topics may include asset tracking, status updates, and system notifications. The session is designed to promote hands-on learning, identify potential process improvements, and ensure alignment across departments.
